Harrison County YMCA – CODE OF CONDUCT

2017 Adult Basketball Leagues

PARTICIPANTS, COACHES, & PARENTS ARE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE HARRISON COUNTY YMCA. ALL PARTICIPANTS, COACHES, AND PARENTS WILL:

- Demonstrate and model the YMCA values of Honesty, Respect, Caring, and Responsibility while participating or representing the YMCA.;
- Present themselves in a mature and orderly manner;
- Respect the Harrison County YMCA and act accordingly;
- Respect the coaches and officials of the Harrison County YMCA;
- Exhibit sportsmanlike conduct at all times;
- Refrain from using profane and abusive language;
- Be a role model for younger team members at all contests/games;
- Show respect to class/team members, coaches, and parents at all times.

THE YMCA IS CONCERNED WITH THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF ITS MEMBERS. ALL PARTICIPANTS/COACHES/PARENTS WILL:

- Please refrain from rough-housing during instructional classes, games, or meetings. This includes bringing any potentially harmful items to these locations.
- The use of drugs of any kind, smoking, and drinking alcohol will not be tolerated.

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Depending on the severity of the misconduct, disciplinary action will be taken against all offenders of the Code of Conduct. Consequences may include one or a combination of the following:

- Receive a verbal warning from the class instructor, coach, referee and/or management staff.
- Ejection from class, game, or meeting.
- Suspension from all classes, league or team activities for a period of time which will be determined by the class instructor, coach, referee and/or management staff.
- All class, league, team or YMCA privileges revoked with no refund of fees paid.

League Rules & Regulations

Game Play:

1. Each game will be two (2) halves of twenty (20) minutes each. The clock will be running EXCEPT during dead balls in the last minute (1) of the first half and the last two (2) minutes of the second half – as long as the game is within 25 points.
2. Each player has 6 personal fouls.
3. Each team has three (3) timeouts per half. These will be recorded; a team technical foul will be issued if a time out is called after the 3rd time out of the half. Time outs are approximately thirty (30) seconds.
4. Free throw situations: you may enter the lane after the ball leaves the shooter's hands.
5. Overtime will consist of a two (2) minute period with stopping clock.

Team Composition:

1. Teams may not consist of a roster with more than twelve (12) players.
2. Teams have until the end of the sixth (6th) week of the season to add players if they have fewer than 12. Any players not on the roster after this date constitutes a forfeit of the game they played. Added players must have a completely filled out waiver form AND a signed Code of Conduct form; all information must go through the YMCA Program Director before playing.
3. At least four (4) players are required to play a game

Other League Rules:

1. Team jerseys (shirts) are required! All players must have a number on the back of the shirt – no duplicate numbers! Teams provide their own shirts.
2. If a team forfeits more than one (1) game, they will be ineligible for playoffs. A team may be terminated at any time during the season, according to the discretion of the YMCA.
3. To be eligible for playoffs, a player must play in at least three (3) regular season games
4. The YMCA will provide a clock keeper, statistic keeper, and two trained referees for each game.
5. Games are rarely cancelled because of weather – if we don't call your captain, the game is on!
6. No HANGING on rims. You may dunk, but do not forcefully pull down! Equipment broken during the course of game will be replaced by the individual responsible for the damages!
7. We provide officials for your benefit – unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated...technical fouls will be assessed!
8. If the team captain and team do not arrive within ten minutes of the start time, that team will automatically forfeit that game.

***Technical Fouls and Conduct Penalties:

- 2 Cumulative Technical Fouls in a Season – ejection from current game + 1 Game Suspension
 - 4 Cumulative Technical Fouls in a Season – Indefinite Suspension of Player + No Playoffs for that player.
 - 10 Cumulative Team Technical Fouls in a Season – No Playoffs for that team.
9. No alcohol/drug use prior to or during a game!! You will NOT play if this is detected!
 10. Team captains are responsible for educating their players on the rules!

*Note: Rules are subject to change at any time. All matters and/or incidents may be subject for further review by the YMCA Program Director.
